Ruins of St. Paul:

The facade was originally part of the St. Paul's College, built between 1602 and 1640. It was destroyed by a fire in 1835, leaving only the front wall. Locals refer to it as the "Ruins of St. Paul's," and it has now become a pilgrimage site for tourists.

Mount Fortress:

Originally an important military site in Macau, it is now one of China's oldest surviving Western-style fort structures. The Macau Museum, built in 1998, is located at the center of the fort.

St. Dominic's Church:

Established by the Dominican Order in 1587, it is also known as the "Our Lady of the Rosary Church" due to its dedication to the Rosary Virgin. Initially constructed with camphor wood, its Baroque style altar is elegant and exquisite.

Senado Square:

For centuries, Senado Square has been the central square of Macau. To this day, it remains a popular venue for public events and celebrations.

Guia Fortress and Lighthouse:

Perched on the highest hill of the Macau Peninsula, Guia Fortress overlooks the entire area. The fortress features a lighthouse and a chapel. The lighthouse is the first modern lighthouse on the Chinese coast.
